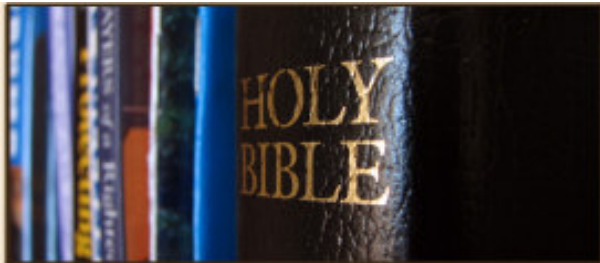
# How to GROW

## New to FMC?

## Familiar with FMC?

- Be part of a standard class.
- Don't miss the combined classes that help you get the most from small groups.
- Consider whether to step away from your standard class briefly for a valuable elective.



## Standard Classes

**Life Together** – Adults in their 20's and 30's seeking fullness of Christian life together by jointly focusing on worship, prayer, fellowship and teaching. **(Library)**

## Carpenter's Tools/Potter's Clay –

Adults with children are in many stages of life who focus on building community and living out our faith. **(Fellowship Hall East)**

**For Ladies Only** – A women's group studying the Word and how it impacts us as women. **(Room 232)**

**Pathfinders** – Adults in the "sandwich" generation – dealing with adult children achieving independence and parents moving toward dependent living. How do we live for God when pulled in many directions? **(Fellowship Hall West)**

**Fellowship** – Adults with families making new homes of their own, who are committed to growing in the Lord and loving each other. **(Room 126)**

**Christian Homemakers** – Adults, retired from work but not from life and ministry, who testify to God's faithfulness and who find God's promises to be true. **(Lower Auditorium)**
